- ◆ Next meeting is on 10/28/21 at 3:30PM
- ◆ For students and staff – a positive case in the household is a mandatory 14-day quarantine from the district (regardless of vaccination status)
- ◆ For Students and staff – if a student or staff member is getting tested for COVID-19 test, they must quarantine until they present the district with a negative PCR test result when testing after 7 days from the most recent exposure (regardless of vaccination status)
- ◆ Individuals will NOT be able to reduce their quarantine time to return to the district by getting tested for COVID-19
