Greetings from the School Nurse at Washington Jr/Sr High School!

While you are enjoying your summer break, please check with your primary care providers to ensure that your child is up to date on all of the Pennsylvania required immunizations. Students entering 7th grade in the Fall MUST have **<u>Tdap and MCV</u>** (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis, and meningococcal) immunizations, unless they have a waiver on file. Students in 8th and 9th grade next year must also have had these two shots. Students entering 12th grade in the Fall MUST have a second dose of the **<u>MCV</u>** (meningococcal) immunization, unless they have a waiver on file.

Please review your child's attached medical health report for the immunizations we have on file. If no immunizations are listed, this means that I do not have record of immunizations that your child has received. You may take this report to your care physician to review for missing shots. If you do not have a primary care physician, the Pennsylvania Department of Health (Washington County) offers a free immunization clinic monthly. <u>You must call for an appointment</u>.
